

- Exhibitor must remain open for the entirety of the expo hours, and should load in or close and load out according to the designated times set by the Organizer.
- No materials on display, distributed, or for sale may be mature-rated. The Organizer reserves rights to remove any materials deemed inappropriate on the expo floor.


